

Institut nordique du Québec's (INQ) Visibility Policy for recipients of INQ financial support

It is mandatory to acknowledge INQ in all communication material related to research projects and activities funded, in whole or in part, by INQ.

Holders of INQ-funded projects are responsible for applying this policy within their research team¹.

By complying with this visibility policy, you will contribute to publicizing INQ's contribution to northern and Arctic research and increase the influence of a research community whose priorities include the sustainable and ethical development of northern and Arctic regions.

Non-exhaustive list of communication material requiring acknowledgement of INQ funding:

- Scientific papers;
- Scientific posters;
- Oral presentations at conferences;
- Multimedia projects for the general public.

To acknowledge the contribution of INQ to your projects, it is mandatory to:

- Add the INQ logo (available here) to your communication material;
- Reference INQ or include the INQ logo on the slides of your oral presentations at conferences:
- Reference INQ or include the INQ logo in the acknowledgements section of your scientific publications or multimedia projects;
- When possible, indicate on websites and on social networks affiliated with the project that INQ is a partner by integrating the INQ logo or by identifying INQ in your posts (LinkedIn, Facebook, Twitter).

The following are three examples of wording that can be used to highlight the contribution of INQ to your projects:

- The research presented in this article was funded by Institut nordique du Québec.
- We thank Institut nordique du Québec for its financial support that made this work possible.
- This project was funded by Institut nordique du Québec.
